How to Use:

1. Go to the Rocket Transportation website.
2. Choose your "Departure Date".
3. Choose your "Pick Up Location". If you want to be picked up at the airport, choose "Seatac".
4. Choose you "Drop Off Location". Choose a location that is near where you want to go. You will be able to enter an exact address later.

5. The next page will show the options available. You don't need to choose an option here. Just click "Make a Reservation".

6. Enter your "Full Name", "Phone Number", and "Email Address". Then click "Next".
7. Verify that the bus has open seats. If there are open seats, the box will be green. If not, the box will be red. You can also see how many open seats on the right side of each box.
8. Type in the name of each traveler and their date of birth. To add more travelers, click the " + " sign. Then click "Next".

Drop Off Point: Choose "Primary Location" and type in the address of where you want to go.
b. Enter your flight information with "Airline Name" and "Flight No.".
c. Enter your flight arrival time.
d. Enter the "Earliest time I am comfortable targeting pickup at Airport". If your flight arrives at 5:00 pm, how much time will you need for Customs and Immigration and how much time will it take to

4. You are looking to buy a ticket from "Airport Seatac" to "Pioneer Square".
5. This is a 35-minute one-way trip, and the estimated cost is $\$ 3.00$ USD. You'll need cash or a credit or debit card to purchase the ticket.

7. Go up the pedestrian walkway into the Seattle Ferry Terminal to buy your tickets.

8. You are looking for the ferry going to "Bainbridge Island". There are only two ferries from Seattle Ferry Terminal so this one should be easy to find. It leaves every 40-60 minutes.
9. The ferry crossing from Seattle to Bainbridge Island is usually 35 minutes. For one adult without a car, bicycle or motorcycle, the estimated cost should be $\$ 9.85$ USD.
10. Enjoy the ferry. Look for whales!
11. When you arrive at Bainbridge Island Ferry Terminal, walk to the area for buses. It should be very nearby.

How to Use:

1. From "International Baggage Claim", after "Customs", you will enter the main arrivals area.
2. Turn right and go to the outside door closest to "Domestic Baggage Claim". Exit the airport.
3. Turn right, and you should see Bus 88 going to "McTavish Exchange".
4. To buy a ticket, there are kiosks in the airport. You can also buy a ticket from the driver, but you need Canadian dollars to do this.
5. Take Bus 88 to "McTavish Exchange". Should be about 4 minutes and cost about $\$ 2.50$ CAD.
6. Change buses to Bus 72 going to "Legislature Terminal".
7. Bus $\mathbf{7 2}$ should be about 52 minutes and cost about $\$ 2.50$ CAD.

4. There, you should see the Uber/Lyft/Taxi pickup area.
5. The trip should take about $35-40$ minutes.
6. The estimated cost of the trip (and costs vary) is: $\$ 56.26$ USD.

How to Use:

1. From "Baggage Claim", follow the signs up the escalators towards "Ground Transportations" and "Door-toDoor Vans".
2. Cross one of the Skybridges and then go down one level to Level 3.
3. Dash's check-in desks are in the center of the plaza, nearest the purple and orange elevator banks.
4. Dash has a free 15 -minute shuttle bus that will take you to the plane.
5. The flight should take about 30 minutes.
6. There are limits on luggage because of the size of the plane. Don't bring too much.
