## Material List:

Paint: (Acrylics only)
Red:

- Quinacridone red, 2 oz tube (bluish red)
- Pyrrole red, 2 oz tube (orangish red)
Yellow:
- Hansa yellow light, 2 oz tube (greenish yellow)
- Diarylide yellow, 2 oz tube (orangish yellow)
Blue:

Green:

- Phthalocyanine green, 2 oz tube (yellow shade [YS] version
White:
- Titanium white, (large tube)

Optional:

- Doxazine purple, 2 oz tube

Color substitutions are fine.
Brushes: (either bristle or synthetic)

- One \#12 1-inch flat
- One \#4 filbert (rounded tip)
- One \#2 round


## Water Jars:

Two

## Palettes:

Inexpensive solid plastic picnic-ware works well for disposable palettes. Bring a plastic container with a tight fitting lid large enough to hold your palettes. Keep the palette in the container to keep the paint from drying out.

## Canvases:

Two pre-stretched canvases at least $16 \times 20$.

## Clothing:

Clothing you don't mind getting paint on.
