Paint: (Acrylics only)

Red:

- Quinacridone red, 2 oz tube (bluish red)
- Pyrrole red, 2 oz tube (orangish red)

Yellow:

- Hansa yellow light, 2 oz tube (greenish yellow)
- Diarylide yellow, 2 oz tube (orangish yellow)

Blue:

 Phthalocyanine blue, 2 oz tube (blue shade [BS] version)

Green:

 Phthalocyanine green, 2 oz tube (yellow shade [YS] version

White:

• Titanium white, (large tube)

Optional:

Doxazine purple, 2 oz tube

Color substitutions are fine.

Brushes: (either bristle or synthetic)

- One #12 1-inch flat
- One #4 filbert (rounded tip)
- One #2 round

Water Jars:

Two

Palettes:

Inexpensive solid plastic picnic-ware works well for disposable palettes. Bring a plastic container with a tight fitting lid large enough to hold your palettes. Keep the palette in the container to keep the paint from drying out.

Canvases:

Two pre-stretched canvases at least 16x20.

Clothing:

Clothing you don't mind getting paint on.
